PLAYERS CODE OF CONDUCT

By becoming a member of the Warwick Greenwood Cricket Club you agree to by abide by the clubs Code of Conduct whether at training, games, official functions or any other occasions whilst representing the Club.

All players of WGCC must abide by the clubs rules & regulations as well as the North Suburban Cricket Association laws and policies adopted by Cricket Australia. The following is part of the list that we wish to highlight to our members as crucial to our success both on and off the field:

- Do not argue with officials. Any disputes or complaints may only be addressed via the Captain or through official channels.
- Display self-control at all times. Verbal abuse of officials, other players, or deliberately distracting or provoking a competitor is neither acceptable nor condoned.
- Work equally hard for yourself and your team.
- Recognise all good performances whether or not they are by your team members or others.
- Treat all members of the Club as you would like to be treated. Do notinterfere with, bully or take advantage of another person.
- Respect and treat politely, family and friends of players that may visit the club at any time.
- Co-operate with Coaches, Captains, team mates at all times.
- Contribute at all times during training and encourage others to do the same. Sitting out after having a bat or bowl is selfish and inconsiderate to others.
- Be appropriately dressed for training and for games.
- Inform Captain or selection committee of availability prior to Thursday before each game. Verbal instruction is **NOT** acceptable.
- Payment of all fees will affect selection if not paid by the due date. Please see the Treasurer if there is any difficulty.
- Carry out reasonable instructions from Captain, Coaches, or Committee.
- Conduct themselves at **ALL TIMES** in a manner that would bring credit to the Club, especially when wearing Club uniform or other identification.
- Social Media is part of our society and we actively encourage contributions and information sharing on the clubs Face Book Page, this is part of the club however care should be taken when posting comments of any sort. Criticism or bullying of the club, club members, Umpires, opposition players or the Association will not be tolerated.

Any misconduct will be dealt with by the Selection Committee and/or the Executive Committee if deemed appropriate.

Penalties may be handed out to any member who is deemed to be in breach ofthe Club Code of Conduct. Penalties may be handed out by the Captain, Selection Committee or Executive Committee but will be done in accordance with the constitution and will involve the Member Protection Information Officer.
